- Ready to use water-based silicone, seals and protects grout from dirt, mildew penetration and odors
- Excellent for protecting new grout
- Keeps restrooms, kitchens and any area with stone or ceramic floors looking new

DIRECTIONS

Wear gloves and chemical resistant safety glasses when working with product.

Prior to applying Grout Shield

- 1) Grout surface must be clean, dry and free of any sealer, wax, dirt or grease residue
- 2) If grout has been previously sealed or had finish, use stripper to remove old finish and follow with Grout Cleaner

Applying Grout Shield

- 1) Pour Grout Shield into a clean, commercial pump sprayer.
- 2) Pre-test grout in an inconspicuous area to insure desired results.
- 3) Spray Grout Shield onto grout surface area.
- 4) Wipe any remaining Grout Shield off tile with a sponge or squeegee. Apply only to grouted area.
- 5) Allow Grout Shield to dry for 30 minutes.

Do not use on glazed tiles or surfaces that have a permanent sealer.
